Vaccination Policy Update

The University of Windsor is following the provincial directive, requiring that all visitors, staff, faculty and students have a government-approved COVID-19 vaccination. Effective September 7, 2021, anyone on campus must complete the Safe Lancer App and show evidence of at least one dose of a Health Canada approved COVID-19 vaccine. Effective October 7, 2021, all on campus must have both doses.
