





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UWinPrep – Quick Facts

- Designed for incoming first-year students domestic, international, mature and transfer.
 - Classes are open to all, including current UW students who are changing programs and want to review/refresh topic material before taking academic classes.
 - While some classes do have recommended prerequisites, none are mandatory.
 - Students can take as many of the classes as they like.
 - Each class is \$350+hst, except Microsoft Excel \$175+hst, including all materials and a Certificate of Completion from University of Windsor Continuing Education

UWinPrep – Quick Facts

- Build confidence before academic classes begin.
- Classes are offered on Blackboard, so students will have an introduction to the UWindsor LMS before academic classes begin.
- The short nature of each class is to provide a refresher, not to replace or re-teach high school classes or Virtual High School Ontario.
- Flexible learning environment and schedule.
- Provide a taste of what's to come in first-year classes.
- Qualified, professional instructors.



Advanced Functions and Problem Solving - 40 hours

July 27-31 and August 4-8, 2020

Live instruction 4pm-5pm EST with approximately four-hours independent study per day consisting of pre-recorded lessons, assigned work, assessments and other activities.

Take this refresher if you are registered in the following UWindsor academic courses:

- Functions and Differential Calculus MATH-1760
- Differential Calculus MATH-1720.

UWindsor prep Advanced Functions & Problem Solving is ideal for:

- Students starting in the Faculty of Engineering, the Faculty of Science and majoring in Forensics, Economics, Environmental Science, Computer Science and Chemistry.
- Students required to take MATH-1760 or MATH-1720 as part of their degree.
- Any other student who wants to refresh their math skills.

Successful completion of MHF4U, Grade 12U Advanced Functions, is recommended.

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Physics - 30 hours

July 27-31 and August 4-8, 2020.

Live instruction 11:30am-12:30am EST with approximately three-hours independent study per day consisting of prerecorded lessons, assigned work, assessments and other activities.

Take this refresher if you are registered in the following UWindsor academic courses:

- PHYS-1300 Introductory Physics for Life Sciences I or
- PHYS-1400 Introductory Physics I

UWindsor Prep Physics is ideal for:

- Students who are starting in the Faculty of Science and majoring in Physics, Biology, Forensics or Chemistry.
- Any other student who is required to take PHYS-1300 or PHYS-1400 as part of their degree program would also benefit from taking this refresher.
- Anyone interested in expanding their understanding of physics knowledge.

Successful completion of SPH4U, Grade 12 Physics and MHF4U, Grade 12U Advanced Functions, is recommended.

Biology - 30 hours

August 10-21, 2020, 9:30am to 12:30pm, weekdays

Live instruction consisting of online lectures, virtual labs and investigations, assignments and case studies as well as formative and summative evaluations.

Take this refresher if you are registered in the following UWindsor academic courses:

- BIOL-1101 Cell Biology or
- BIOL-1111 Biological Diversity

UWindsor Prep Biology is ideal for:

- Students starting in the Faculty of Nursing, Faculty of Human Kinetics, Faculty of Science and majoring in Biology, Forensics, Economics, Environmental Science and Chemistry.
- Any other student who is required to take BIOL 1101 and BIOL 1111 as a part of their degree program would also benefit from taking this refresher.
- Learners interested in enhancing their knowledge of biology.

Successful completion of SBI4U, Grade 12U Biology, is recommended.

Chemistry - 30 hours

August 17-28, 2020, 1:30pm to 4:30pm, weekdays

Online, live instruction supported by short assignments, quizzes and various learning activities.

Take this refresher if you are registered in the following UWindsor academic courses:

- CHEM-1100 General Chemistry I or
- CHEM-1103 Topics for General Chemistry

UWindsor Prep Chemistry is ideal for:

- Students starting in the Faculty of Science and majoring in Chemistry, Biochemistry, Biology, Forensics, Environmental Science and Physics.
- It is also ideal for students who are in Civil Engineering taking CHEM-1103.
- Any other student who is required to take CHEM-1100 or CHEM-1103 as a part of their degree program would also benefit from taking this refresher.

Successful completion of SCH4U, Grade 12U Chemistry, is recommended.

Microsoft Excel for University - 15 hours

August 10-14, 2020, 1:30pm-4:30pm, weekdays Online, live instruction will guide participants through activities and short assignments.

UWindsor Prep Microsoft Excel for University is open to all. It is specifically created for incoming and current students of the University of Windsor or students entering post-secondary education.

This course is recommended for:

- Students in the Odette School of Business
- Students in the Faculty of Engineering
- Students taking any research/statistics course
- Co-op Students
- ANYONE interested in improving their MS Excel knowledge and skills
