AFTER SELECTING YOUR PROGRAM(S)

- Complete the online application form at uwindsor.ca/applynow
 - Pay the fee to process the application
 - Activate your UWin account using the UWindsor ID and Personal Identification Number (PIN) provided via email
- Submit your documents
 - Undergraduate: uwindsor.ca/uwinsitestudent
 - Graduate: uwindsor.ca/egas
 - Electronic copies are sufficient for the application process
 - If official documents are not in English, translation is required by an official translation service
 - Portfolio (if applicable)
- Track your application through UWinsite Student for undergrad students or eGAS for graduate students
- Review & Confirm your offer
 - Should you receive an offer, email instructions will be sent on how to accept the offer online
- Pay your deposit by the date indicated on your offer of admission
- Set up your multi-factor authentication (MFA) options, extend your UWin account and set up UWindsor email
- Verify your UWinsite Student Homepage activation (UG)
