## English Language Improvement Program (ELIP)

If you have an admission offer with a language condition, the English Language Improvement Program (ELIP) is a pathway to meet UWindsor's English language proficiency requirements for undergraduate and graduate programs. [uwindsor.ca/elip](https://uwindsor.ca/elip)

### FEATURES

- Five (5) ELIP levels. Each level is 12 full-time weeks. ELIP level start is based on confirmed English language proficiency.
- Classes are offered each semester throughout the year.
- Successful completion of ELIP 3 meets UWindsor's English proficiency requirements for undergraduate and graduate admissions.



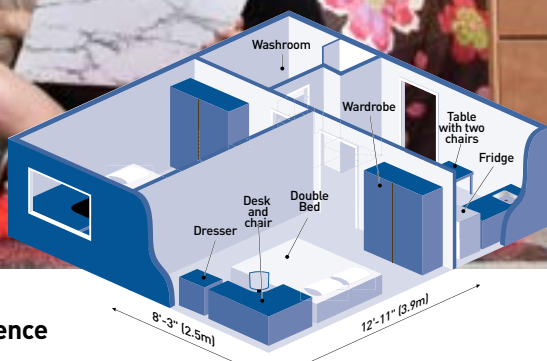

### AFTER SELECTING YOUR PROGRAM(S)

- ☐ Complete the online application form at **[uwindsor.ca/applynow](http://uwindsor.ca/applynow)**
  - Pay the fee to process the application
  - Activate your UWin account using the UWindsor ID and Personal Identification Number (PIN) provided via email
- ☐ Submit your documents
  - Undergraduate: **[uwindsor.ca/uwinsitestudent](http://uwindsor.ca/uwinsitestudent)**
  - Graduate: **[uwindsor.ca/egas](http://uwindsor.ca/egas)**
  - Electronic copies are sufficient for the application process
  - If official documents are not in English, translation is required by an official translation service
  - Portfolio (if applicable)
- ☐ Track your application through UWinsite Student for undergrad students or eGAS for graduate students
- ☐ Review & Confirm your offer
  - Should you receive an offer, email instructions will be sent on how to accept the offer online
- ☐ Pay your deposit by the date indicated on your offer of admission
- ☐ Set up your multi-factor authentication (MFA) options, extend your UWin account and set up UWindsor email
- ☐ Verify your UWinsite Student Homepage activation (UG)

### ☐ Apply for your study permit

- If you are not a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or landed immigrant, you will need to obtain a Study Permit to study in Canada. Visit **[cic.gc.ca](http://cic.gc.ca)**

- ☐ A registration appointment time will be provided by email, with time to plan your courses
- ☐ Register for classes on UWinsite Student

### FOR COURSE-BASED MASTERS PROGRAMS

- ☐ Depending on your program, you may be block registered or assigned an appointment time to register.
  - Block registered students will be contacted by their faculty closer to the registration date
  - All other students will receive an appointment time by email and will be able to plan their own registration and register at the appointed time
- ☐ Register for classes on UWinsite Student, if required
