English Language Proficiency

Applicants whose native language is not English must demonstrate proficiency in English to be considered for enrolment. Here are a few ways it can be demonstrated:

- A minimum score of 6.5 on the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) Academic Test; or
- A minimum score of 83 with a writing score of 20 on the Internet-based Test (IBT) of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL); or
- Completed all secondary or postsecondary education in English speaking countries such as the United Kingdom, West Indies and other countries as specified by the Senate Policy; or

• Completed three years of full-time secondary or post-secondary study in a school where the language of instruction is English (e.g., in a British, Register for the English Language Canadian, American or Australian Curriculum or an international diploma like the International Baccalaureate) and can demonstrate English proficiency. In some cases, an English proficiency test may still be required; or

- Successful completion of the University of Windsor's English Language Improvement Program (ELIP) (level III) with a minimum final grade of 75%.
